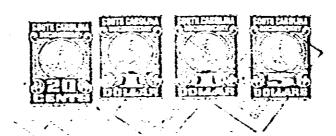

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Bates Township, about three miles north of Travelers Rest, S. C., on U. S. Highway No. 276, and being known and designated as Lot No. 68 of a subdivision of the Nannie K. Hunt Estate as shown on plat thereof prepared by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, November 15 and 16, 1951 and recorded in the HKC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, at page 134, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the eastern edge of U. S. Highway No. 276, joint front corners of Lots 67 and 68, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 64-40 E 200 feet to a stake at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence S 26-00 E 100 feet to a stake at the joint rear corners of Lots 68 and 69; thence along the joint line of said lots S 64-40 W 200 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of U. S. Highway No. 276; thence along the eastern side of U. S. Highway No. 276, N 26-00 W 100 feet to the beginning corner; being one of the lots conveyed to G. P. Peterson by Josephine Vernon, et al. by their deed dated September 22, 1954 and recorded in the REC Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 510, at Page 501.

This is the same property conveyed to Mortgagee's by Deed of G. P. Peterson, dated 11/13/56, being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Book 565, Page 519.

The above described property is conveyed subject to recorded rights-of-way for the installation and maintenance of public utilities.
