

(e) The commencement by Cincinnati of any case, proceeding or other action relating to it in bankruptcy or seeking reorganization, liquidation, dissolution, winding-up, arrangement, composition or readjustment of its debts, or for any other relief, under any bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganization, liquidation, dissolution, arrangement, composition, readjustment of debt or other similar act or law of any jurisdiction, now or hereafter existing; or the application by Cincinnati for a receiver, custodian or trustee of it or for all or a substantial part of its property; or the making by Cincinnati of an assignment for the benefit of creditors; or the inability by Cincinnati or the admission in writing of its inability to, pay its debts as they become due; or the taking of any action by Cincinnati indicating its consent to, approval of or acquiescence in, or in the furtherance of, any of the foregoing.

(f) The commencement against Cincinnati of any case, proceeding or other action in bankruptcy or seeking reorganization, liquidation, dissolution, winding-up, arrangement, composition or readjustment of its debts, or any other relief, under any bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganization, liquidation, dissolution, arrangement, composition, readjustment of debt or other similar act or law of any jurisdiction, now or hereafter existing; or the appointment of a receiver, custodian or trustee of Cincinnati or for all or a substantial part of its property or the issuance of a warrant of attachment, execution or restraint, or similar process against any substantial part of the property of Cincinnati; and in each such case such condition shall continue for a period of 60 days undismissed, undischarged or unbonded.

(g) The occurrence of any event authorizing the holder of any obligation specified in Section 6.08 hereof to accelerate such obligation or take any action to enforce the lien of such obligation.

The provisions of subsection (c) of this Section 9.01 are subject to the following limitations: If by reason of acts of God; strikes, lockouts or other industrial disturbances; acts of public enemies; orders of any kind of the Government of the United States or of the State or any department, agency, political subdivision or official of either of them or any civil or military authority; insurrections; riots; epidemics; landslides; lightning; earthquakes; fires; hurricanes; tornadoes, blizzards, or other storms; breakage or accident to machinery; partial or entire failure of utilities; or any cause or event not
