TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

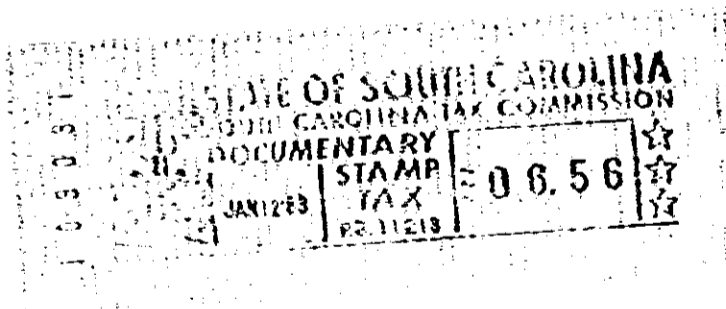
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, the Mortgagee's heirs, successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Saluda Township, being known and designated as a 1.20 acre tract, more or less, bounded on the west by lands of R. L. Burns, on the south by lands of D. W. Johnson, and on the north by Johnson-Greenwood Road, and being all of Tract No. 1 of the L. P. Stroud Estate as shown by plat thereof made by S. C. Moon, dated December 1939.

THIS is the same property as that conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by deed from R. L. Burns recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 864 at Page 381 on March 21, 1969.

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Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

4. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

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
