

Agreement between R.L. Smith & I.B. Rutledge - See Page 155 this Book

It is hereby agreed that I.B. Rutledge who owns Tract No. 2. (Shown on Page 155 this Book) and R.L. Smith who owns No. 3. Shall open a Street 40ft. wide, each of us to give a strip 20ft in width parallel to the Line dividing our properties, and extending from the Spartanburg Road to the rear line, a distance of about 157

It is also agreed that I, I.B. Rutledge will give a 40ft Street Crossing my Property and intersecting the 40' Street in agreement above, the location of same to be as shown on Plot. Both of said Streets are to be used by the present owners and the general public as through fares for Travel.
