 President of Carolina National Bank of Anderson, S. C.
 I have surveyed the Jerry W. Trammel place situated
 about four miles north west of Marietta, in Greenville
 County, on both sides of Cranes or Cranes Creek
 and composed of three tracts: two adjoining and No. 3,
 North East of Tract and about 75 yards apart at the narrowest
 part.

The data for the above survey was obtained from Mr. C. O. Goodwin
 which was a plat made for T. J. Hightower of 840 Acres by F. E. Fuller
 on May 12th, 1856 and certified to by S. M. Barkin, Surveyor General
 which plat is recorded in Grant Book No. VOL. 85 at page 210 in Columbia
 S. C. This tract of land is wholly within the 840 Acres of the T. J.
 Hightower Tract, with courses and distances set out on said Plat.
 The courses and distances of the 24 1/2 Acre tract are set out in a deed
 of Nancy Trammel to A. P. Trammel dated January 3rd, 1892 and
 recorded in Vol. 15 page 217 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.
