
This sheet may be used for tracing plats of tracts of the lands contracted in the chain of title. Place this sheet over the plat to be traced so that the point of origin is as nearly in the center of the sheet as possible; then trace all lines, courses and distances. Always show all adjoining landmarks and indicate the points of the compass and copy all legends or explanatory notes, showing the date of survey, purpose of the same and by whom made.

If the tract is too large to be traced on this sheet, make the tracing first on Sheet Q-1, and then reduce it on Sheet Q in the following manner:

1. If there is a certain corner on the tracing on Sheet Q-1 lie within Block 14-G. Refer to Sheet Q and locate this corner in corresponding Block 14-G. Find the next corner on Sheet Q-1 lies within Block 9-L. Refer to Sheet Q and locate this corner in the corresponding Block 9-L. Draw a line connecting these two points in the corresponding points on Sheet Q are connected. So proceed around the perimeter of the tract and so traced on Sheet Q, indicating the corresponding corners on Sheet Q, and connecting the various corners so located until the point of departure is reached.

This sheet must be inserted in the abstract at its proper place, which is immediately following the instrument or proceedings which refers to the plat to which this is a copy.
