

TRACING SHEET FOR PLATS.

I This sheet must be used for tracing plats of tracts of the lands abstracted in the class of title. Place this sheet over the plat to be so that the same will appear as mearly in the center of the sheet as possible; then trace all lines, courses and distances. Always show all adlandowners and indicate the point of the compass and copy all legends or explanatory notes, showing the date of survey, purpose of the establishment in the plat is too large to be traced on this sheet, make the tracing first on Sheet Q.1, and then reduce it on Bheet Q in the following in Assume that a certain corner on the tracing on Sheet Q.1 lies within Block 14.6. Refer to Sheet Q and locate this corner in corresponding Block 14.6. The next corner on Sheet Q.1 lies within Block 14.6. Refer to Sheet Q and locate this corner in corresponding Block 15.6. Refer to Sheet Q. and content this corner in the corresponding Block 15.6. Refer to Sheet Q. and connecting these two points as the corresponding points on Sheet Q.1 are connected. So proceed around the perimeter of the plat of as traced on Sheet Q.4, locating the corresponding corners on Sheet Q, and connecting the various corners so located until the point of deglis reached.
