Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars on principal on the 11th day of each month hereafter for one year commencing August 11, 1955, and then commencing August 11, 1956, Two Hundred One and 59/100 (\$201.59) Dollars on the 11th day of each month thereafter; payments to be applied first to interest, balance to principal with the privilege to anticipate payment of 20 per cent of the principal in any one year; balance due 20 years from date.

with interest from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum and paid interest to be computed and paid monthly and in unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate of principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if same be collected by attorney or the usual legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN THAT we, the said Lewis C. Black and Rush H. Trammell,

in consideration of the sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of this note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, \$3.00, in hand well and truly paid us and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release unto the said

Franklin National Life Insurance Company, its successors and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel 1, or lot 19 of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot 19 of Adkins Heights property, as shown on a plat thereof presented by Bill P. Loves, as recorded in the R. R. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Book "B", at page 34, excepting a foot strip taken therefrom to widen the alleyway and having according to a survey set by W. D. Waters, April 1920, the following lines and boundaries to-wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Spring Street, 113.3 feet from the southwest corner of the intersection of Washington Street and Spring Street, which is the southeast intersection of Spring Street with a 13.3 foot alley, and running thence with the southern side of said alley 70 ft. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20° E. 0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70° E. 100 feet to an iron pin in line of Spring Street; thence along the eastern side of Spring Street N. 20° E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

The above is the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by deed of Wilkins Norwood, et al dated July 2, 1955, and recorded herewith.

ALSO all those places, parcels, or lots of land, situate, lying and being on the east side of 12th Street near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being shown as lots No. 3, 17, 18, and 19 of Adkins Heights according to plat thereof prepared by S. C. McDaniel Jr. and J. P. Moore dated November 1921, and recorded in the R. R. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "B", at page 67 and having according to said plat the following lines and boundaries to-wit:
