MORTGAGE OF REAL PROPERTY

THIS MORTGAGE made this 9th day of October, 1980, among Robert Lawrence Blich, Jr. and Patricia Blich (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) and FIRST UNION MORTGAGE CORPORATION, a North Carolina Corporation (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee):

WITNESSETH THAT, WHEREAS, Mortgagor is indebted to Mortgagee for money loaned for which Mortgagor has executed and delivered to Mortgagee a Note of even date herewith in the principal sum of Twelve Thousand, Seven Hundred and No/100 (\$ 12,700.00---), the final payment of which is due on October 15, 1987, together with interest thereon as provided in said Note, the complete provisions whereof are incorporated herein by reference;

AND WHEREAS, to induce the making of said loan, Mortgagor has agreed to secure said debt and interest thereon (together with any future advances) and to secure the performance of the undertakings prescribed in the Note and this Mortgage by the conveyance of the premises hereinafter described:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the aforesaid loan and the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) cash in hand paid to Mortgagor, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mortgagor hereby grants, sells, conveys, assigns and releases to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described premises located in Greenville County, South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the eastern side of Coventry Lane, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 76 on a plat of Central Development Corporation recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book BB at Pages 22 and 23, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Coventry Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 76 and 77 and running thence along the common line of said lots S. 77-45 E. 243.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear lines of Lots 93 and 94 S. 2-30 E. 19.6 feet and S. 7-51 W. 40.4 feet, respectively; thence along the common line of Lots 75 and 76 N. 82-32 W. 248.7 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Coventry Lane; thence along the said Coventry Lane N. 9-48 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
