KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I,
T. E. Green, County and State aforesaid, in consider-
ation of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), to me in hand
paid, by A. L. Mills, as President of the Chamber of
Commerce, of the City of Greenville, his successors or
assigns, hereinafter referred to as optionee (the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted
and sold unto A. L. Mills, as President as aforesaid,
the right at any time within five years from the date
of this deed to purchase the land hereinafter described
at the price and on the terms herein stated, for use by
U. S. Government for military purposes.

All that certain tract of land situate in
the County and State aforesaid, containing 81.2 Acres,
more or less, and having the following metes and bounds
to wit:-bounded by lands of B. Perry Edwards, Mrs. Martha
Edwards, other lands of my own, J. H. Fair, and the North
switch road.

The price to be paid is as follows, to wit:
If the terms of this option be accepted within six months
of the date hereof, the price is Two Hundred (\$200.00)
Dollars per acre; if the terms of this option be
accepted after the expiration of six months from the date
hereof, but before the expiration of five years from the
date hereof, the price to be paid is Three Hundred (\$300.00)
Dollars per acre. In either event to be payable
in cash within sixty days after notice in writing the
acceptance of this option.

If written notice should not be given me by
optionee of the acceptance of the terms of this option
within five years from this date, then in such case this
option shall be void.

Notice is hereby given that further use by the War Department of this land or the buildings thereon is terminated, and the lease thereon cancelled.


Acknowledgment is hereby made of receipt of rent due for the fiscal year, 1919.
