You will therefore convene the board at the time this representative reports to you. A Board will be convened at each of the above camps to consist of one representative to be named by the Real Estate Unit, Purchase, Storage and Traffic Division, one to be named by the Construction Division of the Army and one to be appointed by the Camp Commander. Rach of these boards will forthwith investigate and report upon the amount of all possible damage claims which may be asserted against the Government by owners of land leased for the camp because of damages sustained by reason of the Government's compation of their lands, the erection of buildings thereon, the cutting of timber, laying of roads, water pipes or sewers, the construction of trenches or fifle ranges, or by reason of other acts of the Government upon their lands.
