MEMORANDUM FOR THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE ARMY

Subject Camp Sevier, South Carolina.

- 1. The Secretary of War directs that a letter be written to the Construction Division expressed substantially as follows:
 - 1. The Secretary of War has directed the abandonment of Camp Sevier, South Carolina. The Commanding Officer of the camp will furnish to the local representative of the Construction Division such troop labor as may be requested for the dismantling of the camp and the restoration of the property.
 - 2. You are directed to salvage the buildings and improvements in such manner as to best conserve the interests of the Government, and as soon as salvage operations are completed in any given area you will notify the Real Estate Section. Purchase, Storage and Traffic Division, General Staff, so as to enable them to cancel all leases in connection with the same.
 - 3. A preliminary study of this camp indicates that the damage claims will be so great that it would be in the interest of economy to purchase the land and salvage the improvements deliberately, selling the land at a later date. This plan will be thoroughly studied and definite recommendations made to the Director of Operations, General Staff, before any improvements are dismanted
