Pettigru Street in the City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:-

Being lot on South side of Pettigru St. the West boundary of which is 161.1 feet from Carolina Ave. Said right of way being exclusively for the installation of an eighteen inch storm sewer pipe to be laid along western boundary of said lot. To be laid at a depth of two feet below present topography of lot.

For the purpose of establishing or constructing a Storm Sewer

over and through the said premises, for the use of said City.
