Greenville Man Sentenced on Burglary First Degree and Grand Larceny

Thirteenth Circuit Solicitor Walt Wilkins states that CHRISTIAN ARENSON SCOWCROFT, age 26, was convicted on August 24, 2017 by a Greenville County jury of Burglary First Degree and Grand Larceny. He was sentenced to 15 years in the South Carolina Department of Corrections by the Honorable Perry H. Gravely. CHRISTIAN ARENSON SCOWCROFT will have to serve at least 85% of the 15 year sentence before he becomes eligible for parole

Evidence presented at the plea hearing by Assistant Solicitor Brann Fowler established that on August 16, 2016, CHRISTIAN ARENSON SCOWCROFT broke into the house of his former employer after being fired. He stole several firearms and valuable electronics from the victim. He was then found to have sold some of these stolen items almost immediately after they were taken. This case was investigated by GCSO Investigator Robert Grubbs, without whose dogged determination the suspect would not have been brought to justice.
