Authenticated Copy of Judgment from the originating County (note: a certified copy is not sufficient: it must have an authenticating instrument attached to the copy of the Judgment which in most states will be signed by both the Clerk of Court and a State Court Judge of the originating county).
Affidavit of Filing Foreign Judgment which states the following:
a. That the Judgment is final;
b. That it is unsatisfied in whole or in part;
c. The amount remaining unpaid on the judgment;d. Whether the judgment is further contested.
Notice of Filing Foreign Judgment must be served on the Defendant before the judgment is enforceable (30 days after service is accomplished). This Notice may accompany the original filing or be filed within a reasonable amount of time after initial filing.

Please supply any additional copies of the above-listed documents to be returned for service and recordkeeping.
