ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In order to insure the effective utilization of docket time and to insure that adequate docket time is allocated to adjudicate issues before the Court, the following administrative rule is hereby enacted:

In all <u>pendente lite</u> hearings scheduled pursuant to Rule 21 SCRFC each party shall be limited to cight pages of affidavits in hearings scheduled for fifteen minutes or less. Where the issues necessitate more than eight pages of affidavits, additional time should be requested for the hearing. Responding parties for hearings already scheduled may request additional hearing time from the Chief Administrative Judge.

For the purposes of this Order, a page shall include a typed page, a handwritten page, and a partially typed or handwritten page.

For the purposes of this Order only, Family Court Financial Declarations and Attorney Fee Affidavits shall <u>not</u> count as part of the eight page limit. Any other exhibits and/or attachments shall be counted as part of the page limitation imposed under this rule.

For good cause shown the presiding Judge shall have discretion to allow the submission of additional affidavits.

This Order shall become effective on the 1st day of October, 2011 and shall remain in effect until revoked or modified. This order amends to further clarify the prior order of Judge Letitia H. Verdin, dated February 3, 2010.
