- 2. Lawyers need not ask permission to approach the witness.
- 3. Lawyers and parties shall not stand when jury enters or exits the courtroom.
- 4. No speaking objections. Objections made in presence of jury may only include the pertinent rule number or shorthand descriptions (e.g. "Hearsay").
- 5. Opening statements may not exceed thirty (30) minutes per party, and shall not contain argument.
- 6. No photos, slides, or other demonstrative aids or putative exhibits may be shown to the jury before they are in evidence, unless prior consent is obtained from the opposing party and the court.
- 7. No party may examine any witness longer than three (3) hours (exclusive of breaks) without prior permission of the court. This three (3) hour time limit includes re-direct or re-cross. There shall be no re-re examinations.
- 8. No party's closing argument, including reply, shall exceed one (1) hour.
