To protect the privacy rights of minors in cases involving the alleged sexual abuse of a minor where there is a video or audio tape of an interview of a witness under the age of 18, and to ensure defendants reasonable access to such evidence, IT IS ORDERED:

- Upon proper request from defense counsel, a copy of the videotaped interview of a child witness shall be made available to the defense;
- That no additional copy of the tape nor any portion of the tape shall be made by the defendant, the defendant's attorney, investigator, expert, or any other representative or agent of the defendant, or the solicitor;
- If any additional copy is requested from the State, there must be a specified reason,
 and the copies will be numbered to ensure all are returned at the time specified;
- That the copy shall not be used for any purpose other than to prepare for the defense in the action;
- 5. That the copy shall not be publicly exhibited, shown, displayed, used for educational, research or demonstrative purposes, or used in any other fashion, except in judicial proceedings in the action;
- 6. That the copy may be viewed only by parties, their counsel and their counsel's employees, investigators, experts, or witnesses necessary for investigation of the case;

- 7. That no transcript of a copy, nor the substance of any portion thereof, shall be divulged to any person not authorized to view the tape;
- 8. That no person shall be granted access to a copy, any transcription thereof, or the substance of any portion thereof unless that person has first agreed in writing that he has received a copy of this Order, and that he submits to the Court's jurisdiction and contempt powers or sanctions for any violation of the Order. In the event counsel is substituted or added, the new counsel must acknowledge receipt of this order in writing;
- 9. That if any party violates any terms of the agreement, the Court may impose appropriate sanctions including contempt;
- 10. That upon final disposition of the case, any copies of these tapes and any transcripts not already admitted into evidence in the case, shall be returned to the 13th Circuit Solicitor's Office.
