CountyTo Begin Responding to the Review Comments, Please**Do The Following Process:**

- 1. Go to your email and open the Review Comments Letter (Microsoft Word document) that was emailed to you by LDD's Permit Coordinator.
- 2. To start making comments, click inside the section named "Engineer Response Comments". See example in slide # 9. Please change the font to any dark color (no light colored font) of your choice and be sure that the font size is set to at least 10. Begin making your comments. Once complete, save as a PDF and name the document "Engineer Response Letter".
- 3. Upload the Engineer Response Letter into the "resubmittal" folder and then into the sub folder named "Engineer Response Letter". Also remember to upload all other items as requested in the review comments letter into their designated folders.
