- 1. "Incapacity" means the inability to effectively receive, evaluate, and respond to information or make or communicate decisions such that a person, even with appropriate, reasonably available support and assistance cannot:
- a) meet the essential requirements for his/her physical health, safety, or self-care, necessitating the need for a guardian or;
- b) manage his/her property or financial affairs or provide for his support of for the support of his legal dependents, necessitation the need for a protective order.
- 2. A "guardian" means a person appointed by the Court as a legal guardian for an adult, but excludes one who is a guardian ad litem. A guardian shall make decisions regarding the incapacitated individual's health, education, maintenance, and support.
- 3. A "conservator" means a person appointed by the Court to manage the estate of an incapacitated individual.
