Development of W. Walt Wilkins 2020 Anti-Drug Poster Calendar



This calendar was made possible by these students. Our thanks to each of you for your support of drug-free schools in Greenville and Pickens counties.





As the Solicitor for Greenville and Pickens Counties, I am entrusted with the duty of prosecuting drug offenses and further crimes in our community motivated by drugs. I see every day the tragic consequences they can have on a person, their families, and friends. Drugs and addiction not only affect the person using them, they also harm a person's loved ones, their neighbors, and others. Drugs also do not discriminate; they affect those of all ages, races, genders and economic backgrounds, so we must all stay vigilant in the pursuit to end drug abuse and addiction in our community.

It is up to you, the young leaders of tomorrow, to look out for yourselves and each other in the fight against drugs and addiction. As your excellent posters have shown, it is very important that you be aware of the warning signs of drug abuse, to look out for your friends and neighbors, and to know the many resources available to you if you or someone you know is struggling with drugs or the effects of drugs. I am thankful for your thoughtful submissions for the Anti-Drug Poster Calendar Competition, and greatly encouraged that together we can truly make a difference in curbing drug abuse and addiction in the upstate.

Warning Signs:

How can you tell if your child is abusing drugs or alcohol?

There is no single telltale pattern, experts say - especially since the teenage years often produce unpredictable behavior changes. There are, however, some tip-offs that your child may be struggling, including:

- Chronic eye redness, sore throat and/or dry cough.
- Chronic lying or unusual secrecy.
- Trouble in school or with the law, such as stealing.
- Deteriorating relationships with family and friends.
- Wild mood swings, hostility or abusive behavior.
- Chronic fatigue, withdrawal, carelessness about personal hygiene.
- Major changes in eating or sleeping patterns.
- Changes in grades, including increased grades due to misuse of stimulants.

A Message From Just Say Something:

Dear Parents,

Red Ribbon Week is the perfect opportunity for parents and grandparents to start and continue important conversations about drugs and alcohol that will lead to healthier choices and stronger connections with their children. Parents have the greatest influence on their children, especially in the early years. Time is precious to everyone and it is the most valuable resource we can share with our children. Teachable moments occur every day and parents should see these as the opportunity to talk to their children about tough subjects such as drugs, alcohol, and other challenges. What you say doesn't have to be perfect; it just has to be honest, from the heart, and in their best interest.

You should know everything there is to know about your child--their likes and dislikes, their favorite subject(s), what they like to do for fun, who their friends are, and their friends' parents. Parents and grandparents are in the unique position of spending time every day with their children so they have the ability to have ongoing conversations about the dangers of substance use and other risky behaviors. So, while you may never be an expert, you can still learn what you need to know in order to protect your child and help them live life to the fullest and free of substance use and addiction.

Thank you for helping our children to choose a healthy, substance-free future.

If you suspect your child is taking drugs, here's what you can do:

- Do not blame yourself.
- Do not confront a child under the influence of alcohol or another drug, but instead wait until they are sober to discuss your suspicions calmly and objectively.
- Set rules and firm standards and impose consequences when they are broken
- Seek evaluations from health and medical professionals.
